furniture warehouse – and is neighboured by some equally-beautiful listed buildings. The nearby Leadenhall Market, which dates back to 1321 and is just a minute's walk from 24 Lime Street, provides even more local history and a compelling nearby source of lunchtime options. And, of course, the highly central location means there's no shortage of handy transport connections, including Bank and Fenchurch Street underground stations.

Each of the serviced office spaces within the workplace is refurbished to a high standard, with all of the fixtures and fittings you need to make them your business's home. They're available on flexible terms in a range of sizes to suit any business, and come inclusive of cleaning, maintenance, utilities, business rates, and more. 
Map location
